What is our mission?

What denomination is Life Church?

Life Church is a non-denomination church that is open to people of any religious background. We endeavor to follow the pattern of worship and living as laid out in the New Testament. Our focus is on helping people become who God created them to be.

What do you have for my kids?

LifeKids is an exciting and engaging experience for children 3 months—12 years old where kids come and learn about their relationship with Jesus Christ. LifeKids meets during the adult service. What differentiates Life Church from other churches?

You will often hear Life Church described as an "outwardly focused" church. This means that we focus most of our resources, activities and acts of service in the community around Life Church. This includes the west side of Indianapolis and areas such as Wayne Township, Plainfield, Avon and Brownsburg. We believe the church should have a positive impact on the community and people that are around it. There are many great churches in and we encourage you to ask God where He wants to plant you. If Life Church isn't the right place for you, we will do anything we can to help you find the spiritual family where God wants you.



Where are ministries for men, women, singles, couples, etc.?

All ministry and activities happen through our Life Groups. We encourage you to explore the current groups and find one that seems to be a good fit for you.

What are Life Groups?

Life Groups are integral to all we do at Life Church. They are small groups of people that meet on a regular basis to explore God, build friendships, encourage and support each other. There are a wide variety of groups, including groups for Men, Women, Teens, Families, Couples, etc.



Do you have plans for a permanent building?

Using rented facilities allow us to focus our resources and efforts on outreach in the community. While there are some inconveniences with not having our own building we believe the opportunity to use our resources on the community around us is the best use of what God's given us at this time. This also allows us to be in multiple locations close to where people live instead of expecting people to travel to our building.



Will I be asked to give money?

No. Giving is an act of worship for believers. You are welcome to give an offering but are not expected to. No pressure will ever be put on anyone to give.
