Study/prayer time: *Please feel free to adjust this study to fit your group's needs and to God's leading. It is not necessary to use all of the questions.*

1. Have you experienced a time where you've served God alongside your spouse or your family? What was it like?
2. Have someone read Genesis 2:24. How would you explain to someone what the Bible means by a man and woman becoming "one flesh" in marriage? What practical implications does this have in regards to how we live our lives as a married couple?
3. Scott shared this quote on Sunday by author Gary Thomas:
"When marriage becomes our primary pursuit, our delight in the relationship will be crippled by fear, possessiveness and self centeredness. We were made to admire, respect and love someone who has a purpose bigger than ourselves, a purpose centered on God."

Do you think this is true? How have you seen this play out in your own life or the lives of others?

4. What passion, dream or vision has God given you that's bigger than your marriage/family/self (depending on where you are in life)?
5. Think back over the last four weeks. What one idea stands out the most to you? Name one thing that you are doing (or intend to do differently) as a result of what we've been discussing in this series.

Prayer Time: This week in your prayer time, go around the circle and have everyone pray at least once sentence about something they want to thank God for. This is a good way to challenge people who normally don't pray to speak up.
